

# A FLORAL ENCOURAGEMENT CARD 5 EASY STEPS

Hey makers! Get ready to dive into your stash and create a beautiful encouragement card in just five simple steps. This project uses lovely blue and green tones to craft a cheerful, layered design perfect for brightening someone's day!

Follow these steps to assemble your card:

#### STEP 1 - FOCAL POINT

Die-cut and layer flowers from the Hero Arts Large Flower Layering Die set using White, Fog, and Peridot cardstock. Assemble all the floral elements.

#### STEP 2 - HOME PANEL

Die-cut 2 panels using the Spellbinders Lots of Stripes Die set with Windy and Partly Cloudy cardstock. Glue together. Save the negative strips. Add Flowers to he top.

### STEP 3 - SENTIMENT

Stamp your message on the negative strips from Step 2 using the Hero Arts Message Strips Stamp and Cut Set. add them to the home panel stripes.

## STEP 4 - BACKGROUND

On an Oceanside A2 panel, blend Tumbled Glass Distress Oxide ink over the Hero Arts Stacked Circles Stencil (3/4 from the top). Cover the stenciled seam with a 1/4" strip of Beeswax cardstock, add to card base. Add home panel.

#### STEP 5 - EMBELLISH

Add black dots to the flowers centers with a gel pen. Use Glaze n' Glue in the flower centers and add Spellbinders Color Essential Gems Spectrum AB.
